

Proclamation of The Lambs®

Whereas The Lambs is America's oldest professional theatrical organization, founded in New York City December 1874 as a gathering place for professionals in entertainment and the arts; and incorporated in the State of New York on May 9th, 1887.

Whereas The Lambs' 13th clubhouse, designed by Lamb Stanford White, was located at 128-130 West 44th Street from 1905 to 1975.

Whereas Sardi's, the birthplace of the Tony Awards and popular theatrical bar and restaurant, was founded on 44th Street in 1921, and relocated to its current 44th Street location in 1927.

Whereas From 1927 until 1975 The Lambs and Sardi's were located a mere 1,050 feet apart.

Whereas Sardi's famed walls are adorned with many caricatures of the famous and influential talents of American Theatre, dozens of whom were/are members of The Lambs.

Whereas Sardi's became a temporary gathering spot for Lambs 1975-1976, before The Lambs relocated to its 14th and current clubhouse at 3 West 51st St.

Whereas For 90 years members of The Lambs have frequently enjoyed, and today continue to enjoy the hospitality of Sardi's.

Therefore As of this 30th day of August, 2017, be it known to all, that outside of our own Clubhouse, The Lambs officially proclaims Sardi's as its favorite watering hole.
