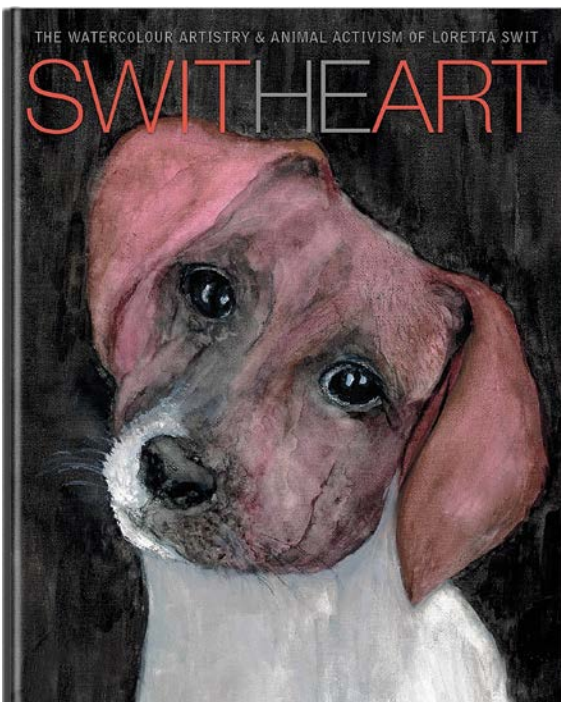

As quick-witted, impassioned Major Margaret Houlihan of television's most honored series, *M*A*S*H*, Ms. Swit became an American icon. And with its popularity now in worldwide syndication, new fans continue to enjoy her lavish portrayal of the sensuous, sensitive, comedic Major Houlihan.

Ms. Swit is as impassioned about animals as she is about the Arts. For her ceaseless humanitarian efforts, Ms. Swit has earned the respect of both the general public and the philanthropic world including such awards as: *Woman of the Year* by both the Animal Protection Institute and the International Fund For Animal Welfare (IFAW); *The Advocate for Farm Animals Award*, 2007 (The Farm Sanctuary); *Compassion in Action Award* (Ayla's Acres); *Westminster Animal Welfare & Leadership Award*; *International Red Cross Humanitarian Award*, 2016; *Global Wildlife Conservation Champion Award*, 2016 (GES Africa Conservation Fund); and *The Betty White Award*, 2016 (Actors and Others for Animals).
